We are mere custodians of Loveday Hall and the beautiful countryside it sits in, and we want it to be enjoyed for many generations to come. Reducing the impact of the weddings we host is a mission that is being driven by the owners, Petra and Jay, but is something that every team member is passionate about.

Our goal: To reach net-zero by 2035.

Our progress: We achieved a 12% reduction this year, which

means we are on track for our 2035 goal.

[H3]: Want to host a carbon-neutral wedding?

Body copy:

Carbon neutrality means that any CO2 released into the atmosphere from your wedding is balanced by an equivalent amount being removed through carbon offsetting. This practice has received criticism for not always having the intended impact, so we like to keep things simple - we plant a tree for every wedding we host. We also reduce our carbon footprint as much as possible; a mission that is ongoing for us here at Loveday Hall.

[H3]: Our decarbonisation projects

- We are lucky that nature provides a stunning backdrop for our couples, and we work with local florists who routinely forage our woodlands to add to their displays. Our trusted floral suppliers offer a range of styles, but all use UK grown flowers, eliminating air travel from your bouquet's journey.
- As a sustainable wedding venue, we're proud to say that our fossil fuel usage has been dramatically reduced through the installation of solar panels. We now generate around 80 kWh of renewable energy on sunny days, enough to cover several hours of power use in our Feasting Marquee.

- We have an EV charging point installed for guest use. We also encourage guests to lift share to overnight accommodation by providing a noticeboard for them to write the details of their departure for others going in the same direction.
- Meat accounts for nearly 60% of all greenhouse gases from food production, so while we happily cater for meatlovers, we have designed our menus to be plant-first. That means plant-based catering is the rule, not the exception but it's all equally delicious.

[H2]: Circularity

Our goal: To reduce the waste we take off site by 50% by 2035 (compared to 2019).

Our progress: We achieved an 11% reduction this year.

[H3]: Around and around we go

At Loveday Hall, we're an eco friendly wedding venue where everything is built to last. From our linen napkins to our wedding toppers, they have been guests at many weddings - and we like to think they bring good luck to every bride and groom.

Anything we do throw away is dealt with by a local waste management company that specialises in sustainable solutions, and we're proud to say that we reduced our waste by 19% compared to last year.

But circularity isn't just about sending waste away to be made into new items - we encourage it within our own premises. Look carefully and you might spot where one of our gates has been turned into an altar, or the retired farming equipment given a new purpose at the bar.

[H2]: Nature

Our goal: To incorporate nature-friendly measures into every new project we undertake on site.

Our progress: This year, we created a habitat wall along one side of the barn that we restored, as well as adding two beehives to our apiary.

[H3]: Bee-friendly by design

Body copy:

Feast with us and you might hear the buzz of the bees that produced the honey drizzled over the cheese you're enjoying. We've got hives on-site, alongside a range of other nature-friendly measures, including bat boxes, nesting rafts and a habitat wall that covers the whole of one side of our barn. We keep certain areas of the woodland for the animals only, and we've been lucky enough to have deer and the occasional fox as guests at our couples' nuptials.

[H2]: Social impact

Our goal: To use only suppliers within a 50 mile radius of Loveday Hall.

Our progress: We have had to reach beyond 50 miles this year as several of our suppliers have gone out of business, but intend to continue our mission to champion our local economy.

[H3]: Catering with a local touch

Body copy:

We're part of the local community, and we're on first name terms with all of our suppliers. From David, who keeps us stocked up with the finest of wines, to Ruth, who has been known to turn around the most unusual wedding cake requests in mere hours. We keep this ethos throughout all of our catering, offering smoked meats from The Orney Smokehouse, oysters from Slates and Mmm Cheese for...well, cheese.

Not only does this local connection help support our local economy, it reduces the food miles travelled. (In fact, many of the herbs you'll enjoy have travelled just metres, from our herb garden to your plate.)
